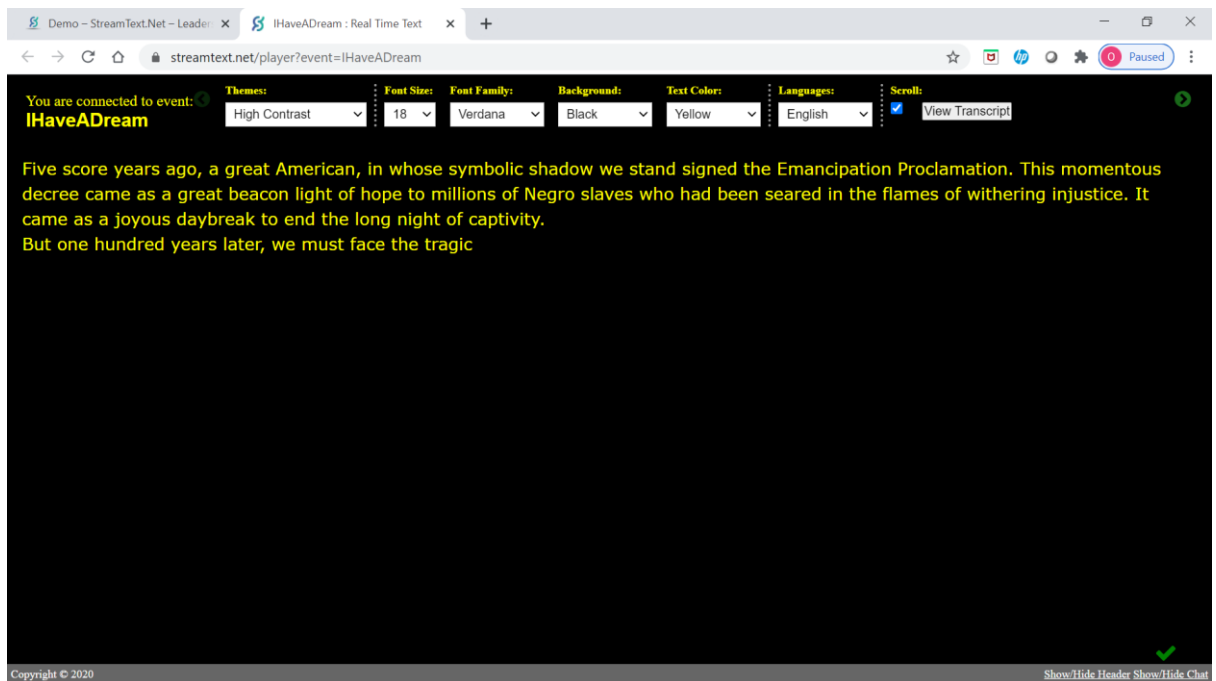




Guide on how to view captions on StreamText

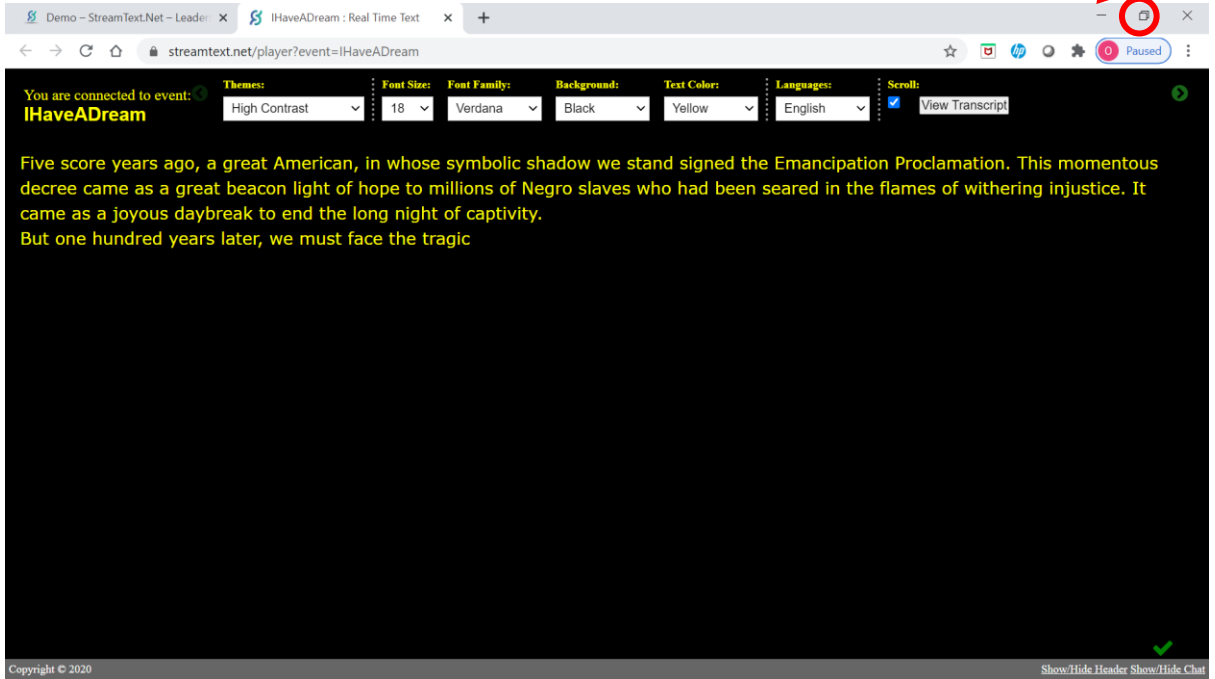
- To view the captions, click on the StreamText link provided.
- The link will open and the captioner's text will appear in the screen as they type, like this.



- The page will be like a normal webpage so you can access it and adjust the window like you would do with a normal website.



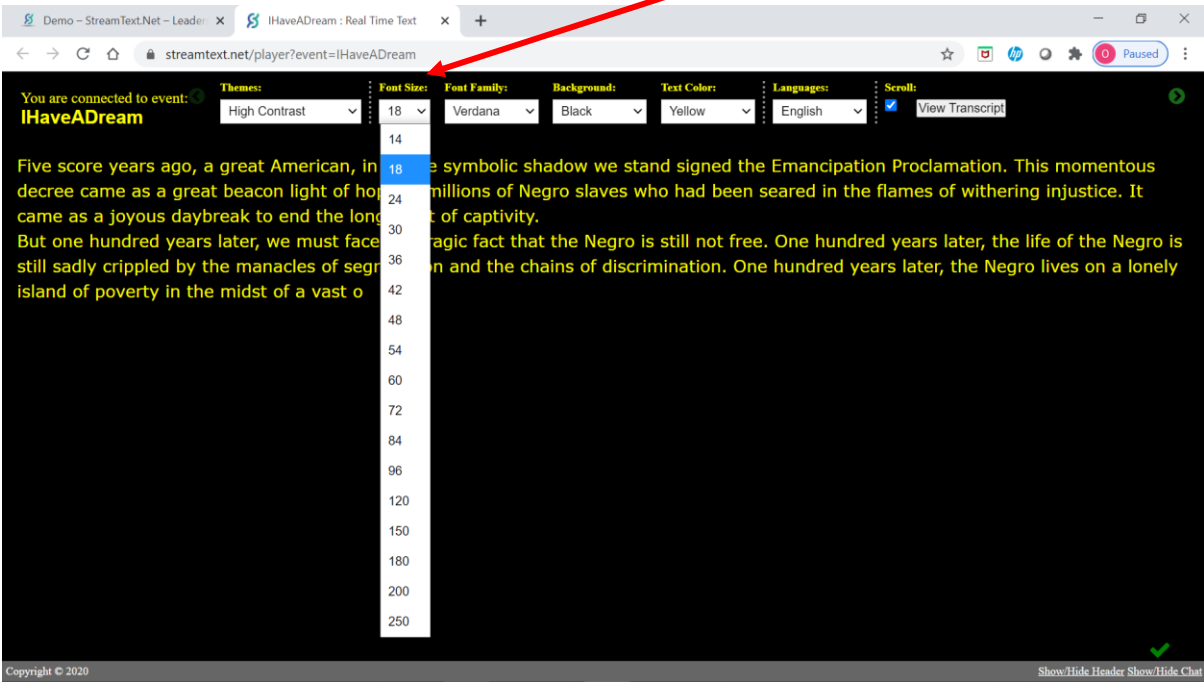
- Click here to make the window smaller to fit it next to other programmes (for example Zoom).



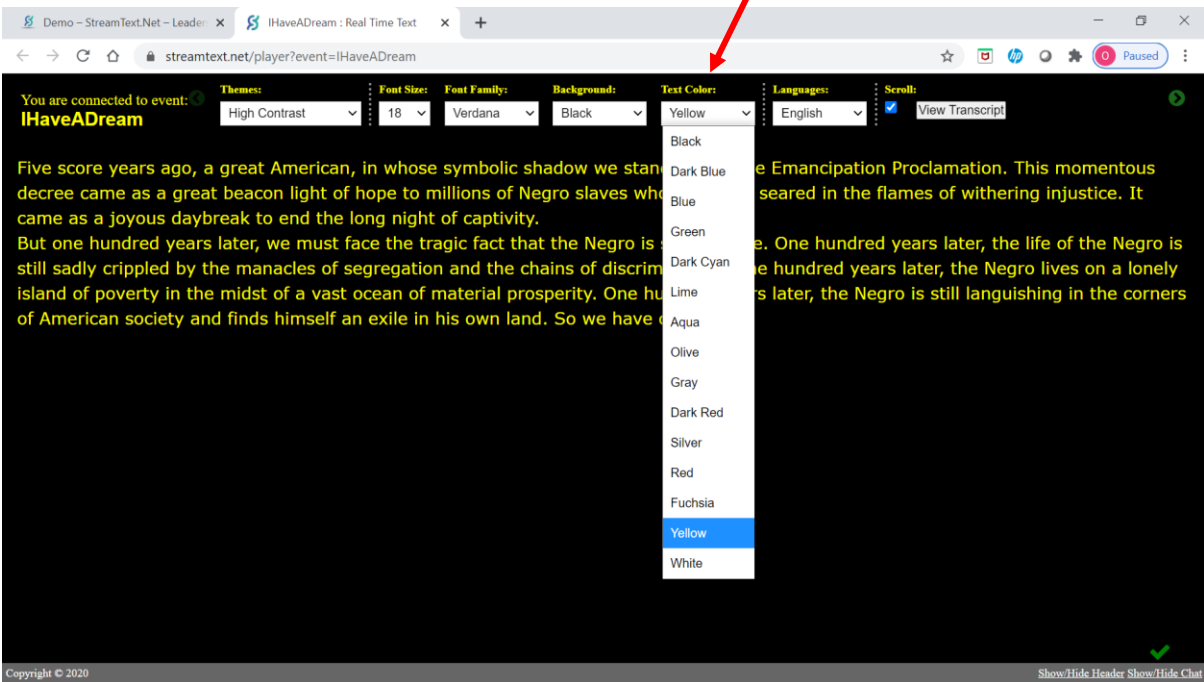


Advanced options: changing text size, colour, font and background.

- You can change the text size by clicking here.

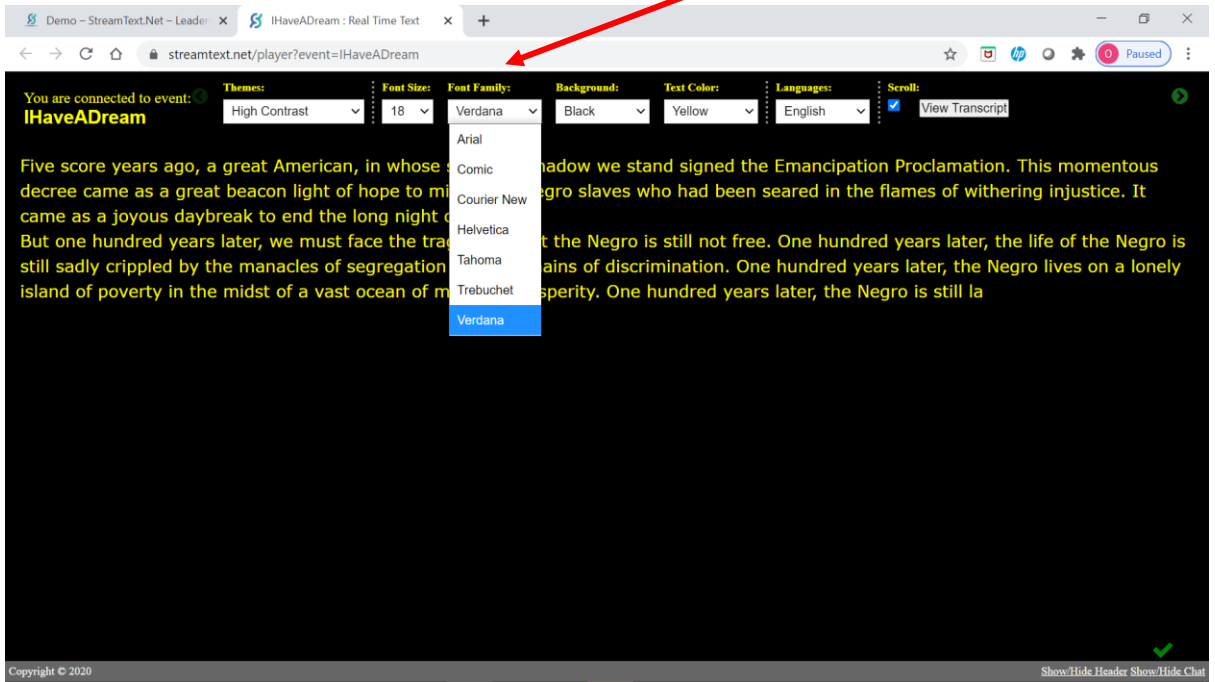


- You can change the text colour by clicking here.



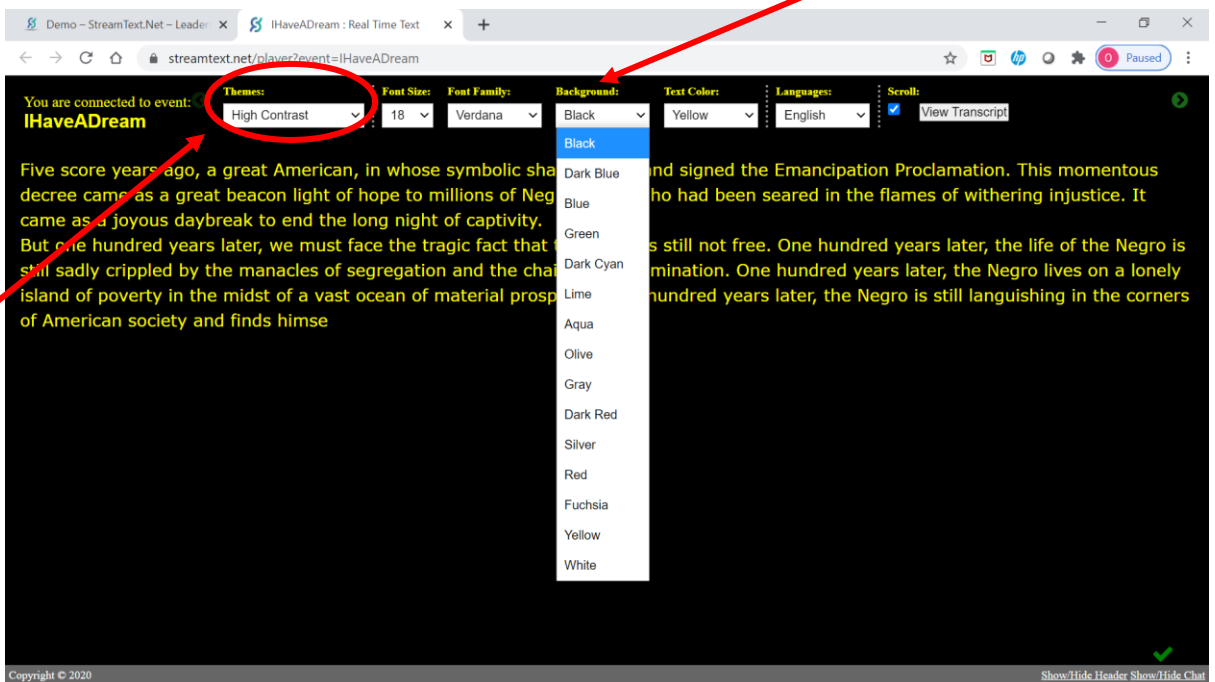


- Verdana as a Font Family (displayed in this example) is an easily read font however, you can change it by clicking here.
